WHY BECOME A MEMBER?

THE ADVISORY BOARD

The Advisory Board and its committees meet for business and social activities each February in connection with the annual Oil and Gas Law Conference, and at other times during the year. Other special events include the John Rogers Award Dinner and the Deans of Oil and Gas Lecture Luncheon, presented during the Annual Oil and Gas Law Conference, and the Special Achievement in Energy Litigation Award Luncheon during the Annual Energy Litigation Conference.

PROGRAMS AND PUBLICATIONS

Each year the Institute for Energy Law offers its two-day *Annual Oil and Gas Law Conference*, which was first presented in 1949 and is now the oldest continuing legal education program in the country. Other annual programs include the *Power and Alternative Energy Conference*, *Energy Litigation Conference*, *International Oil & Gas Law Conference*, *International Energy Law, Contracts and Negotiations – Upstream*, *International Energy Law, Contracts and Negotiations – Midstream*, and a fundamentals *Short Course on Oil and Gas Law*.
