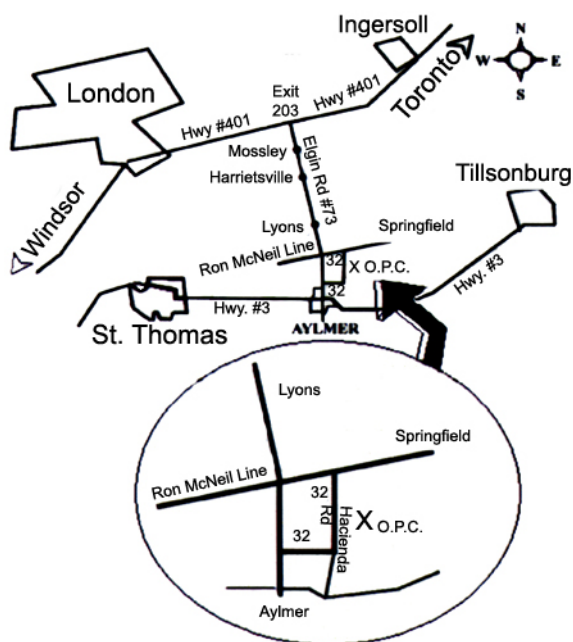


ONTARIO POLICE COLLEGE

The Ontario Police College is situated on 121.5 Hectares of rural land, approximately 5 kilometers northeast of the town of Aylmer and 190 kilometers west of Toronto.

Directions to OPC



By Air:  
London International Airport (about 40 minutes by car)  
Toronto's Pearson International Airport (about 2 hours by car)

By Car:  
Take Highway 401 to Elgin Road 73 (Aylmer Exit)  
Proceed south through the town of Lyons  
Turn east (left) onto Ron McNeil Line  
Turn south (right) onto Hacienda Rd.  
Turn left onto College grounds

The cost of cab fare from London to OPC is approximately \$50.00.

Registration will be conducted between 1800 and 2200 hours on the evening prior to course commencement (for those requiring accommodations). Please sign in at the front reception area and you will receive your key at that time and instructions on where to park depending on where your room is. Meals (cafeteria style) are provided and those with accommodation will need to bring their own towels and personal items. Meals will not be provided on the night of check-in. Participants must be checked out of their rooms by 1630 the last day of the conference.

The course will commence at 0830 sharp in room 102 and for those not requiring accommodations or arriving the morning of the workshop, please register at 0800.

We have an indoor pool, full exercise facility and licensed lounges. Smoking is prohibited everywhere in the building.
