ILEA MEMBERSHIP

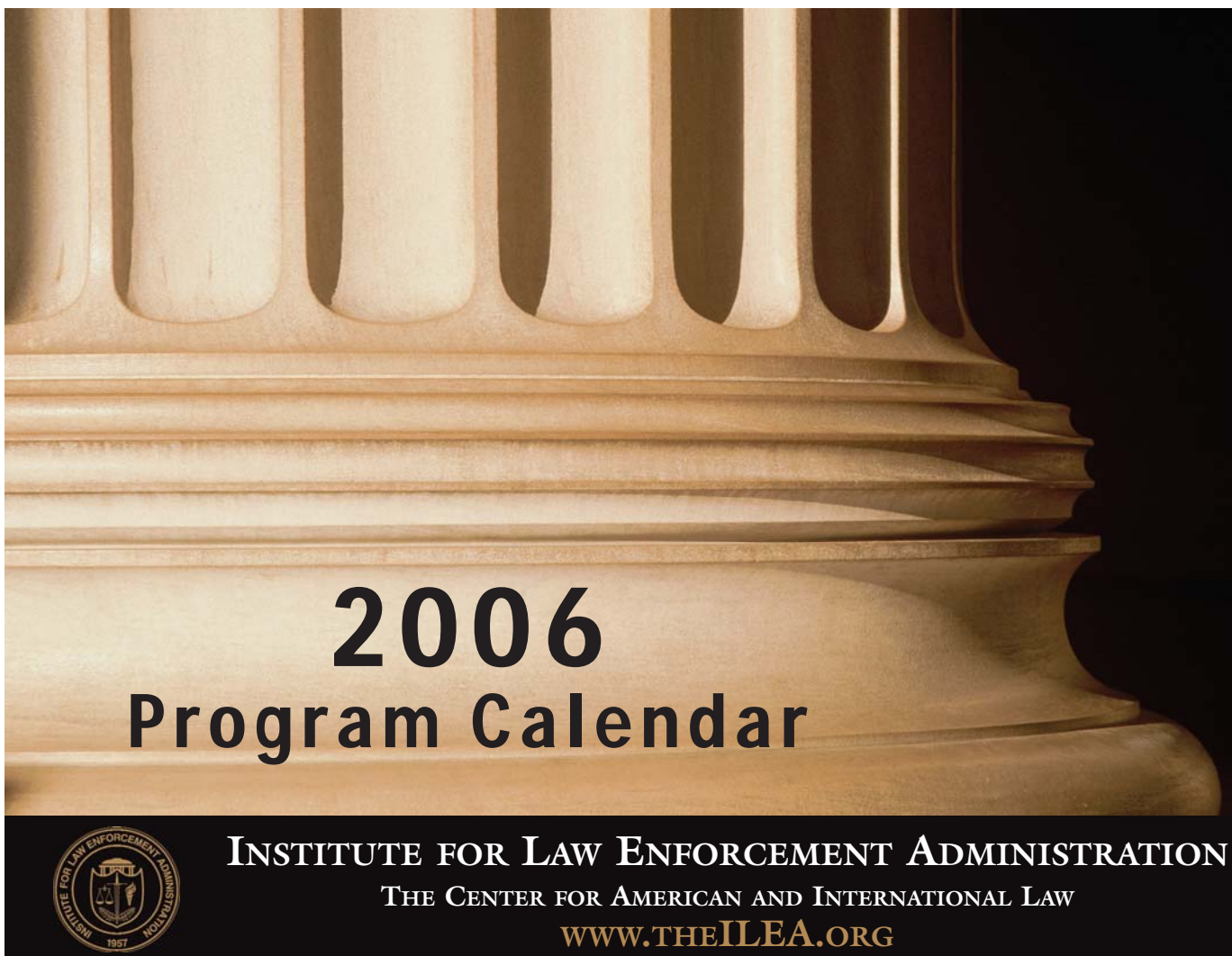
